RULES FOR COMPLETION OF MATCH RESULT SHEET

- All match result sheets must be fully completed (All sections).
- Names of all players must be printed in full (First names & Surnames).
- Registration number issued by the league must be included.

SUBSTITUTIONS

- Time of substitution must be show next to player who has been substituted.
- The substitute used must have the number of the player shown whom he has replaced.

YELLOW & RED CARDS

- Yellow & Red cards must be shown against the player concerned.
- The match referee will verify all yellow and red cards before signing the match result sheet.

MATCH REFEREE

- The match result sheets, showing all players taking part, to be given to the match referee before the commencement of the match.
- No alterations to be made to the match result sheet unless approved by the match referee.
- The match referee to retain the match result sheet until the end of the match.
- At the end of the match the match referee will sign the match result sheet in the presecence of the home and away clubs, after indicating all yellow & red cards and substitutions.

CLUBS

- Match result sheets to be given to the match referee before the commencement of the match.
- No alterations to be made to the match result sheet unless approved by the match referee.

END OF MATCH

- Match referee will return match result sheet to home club.
- Both clubs will then sign the match result sheet and give a copy to the match referee.
- Both clubs will then insert the match referees marks.
- A copy will then be sent to the league.
